European Peoples' Festival Schifflange 2022 Sports Competitions

1. Sports competitions during Euro festival

Among the demonstrations and contests organized within the Eurofestival appear sports competitions between teams of the participating cities. These sport events are presented in the form of true competitions, inciting the young people to put their talent at the profit of their delegation. The fact of presenting in each of the five sports appearing in the program a mixed team of boys and girls, men and women, gives a character specific to the tournaments. The friendly character and the prevalence of the entertainment rather than the aggressiveness to win create an unforgettable experiment among the participants.

2. Rules for the Sports Competitions.

The Rules for the various sports are given again in chapter 3. Competitions

2.1. The mixed team peculiarity of Sports

All the sporting competitions of the Eurofestival are played by mixed teams (men and women). The minimum of female players present on the play-ground, respectively in the teams is given again in the chapter « Participation » of each sport.

A female player dropping out because of an injury or any other reason, can only be replaced by another female player. In case a team has only one female player, the team must play in with one player less.

2.2. Judges and Referees

The judges and referees in the various competitions are designated by the organizer. They are in general national referees or/and experienced competitors.

2.3 Jury of appeal

The jury of appeal decides in disagreements which can't be decided by the judges and referees on the spot. To be admissible, the appeal must be formulated in writing.

The composition of the jury of appeal for all the sports is:

- four members of the sporting cell of the organizer and
- one person on responsible for the teams concerned with the appeal.

2.4. Attribution of points and classification

In each sport there will a classification of the teams according to the disputed matches. The first team 12 points, the second 11 and so on. A team not taking part in the competition or dropping out will be allotted O point.

The classification of the teams eliminated after the qualification matches will be done:

- 1° according to the score in direct confrontation
- 2° according to the score of the disputed matches.

If it come not to a decision between teams, the teams with equality will shares the points to be allotted.

The winning teams of the various Sports Categories will be awarded on Friday 29.07.2022

4. Basketball

4.1 Generalities

Venues

The basketball competitions are held in two sports halls with synthetic floors on regular fields. The eliminating heats will take place on the two following sites:

The semi-finals and finals will be played in the Centre Sportif.

4.2 Competitions

Rules

The tournament will follow the FIBA rules, with following EPF2022 exceptions.

Participation

The number of players is not limited.

Each match will be played by five players with a minimum of two female players.

Tournament

The tournament will be played on 3 groups on normal playground. Group A:4 teams ; group B:3 teams ; group C:4 teams

- The qualification heats will take 1 x 15 minutes, no time stop and no time out.

Game won: 3 points, draw: 1 point, lost: 0 point

- Fouls in the matches: 4 team fouls, 4 personal fouls
- Flying substitutions during the matches
- Shoes with black soles are not allowed indoor.
- no dunking allowed

In each group all the teams play one against the other (round Robin system).

The tree best teams of group A and C and the two best teams of group B are qualified for the quarterfinals. To decide between teams with equality of points, will be considered : 1 $^{\circ}$ match between concerned teams, 2 $^{\circ}$ the goal difference.

Ouarter-Finals:

The playing time is 1x20 minutes, no time stop, no time-out.

In case of equality after 20 minutes the five players on the ground at the end of the playtime (20') take a free shot.

The winner of each quarterfinal is qualified for the semi-finals.

The teams not qualified for the semi-finals will be classified by goal difference. In case of equality the teams concerned are classified at the same place.

Semi-Finals:

The playtime is 2 x 15 minutes. The change of sides will be done after 15 minutes. The matches will be played without stop of stopwatch except for the time-out during which the stopwatch will be stopped. Each team can take one time out per halftime.

In case of equality after 2 x 15 minutes the five players on the ground at the end of the playtime take a free shot.

The winner of each semi-final is qualified for the Final.

The teams not qualified for the semi-finals will be classified by goal difference. In case of equality the teams concerned are classified at the same place.

Final:

The playtime is 2 x 15 minutes. The change of sides will be done after 15 minutes. The matches will be played without stop of stopwatch except for the time-out during which the stopwatch will be stopped. Each team can take one time out per halftime.

In case of equality after the regular playtime a prolongation of 5 minutes will be done. If after the prolongation the equality persists, five players on the ground at the end of the playtime take a free shot.

5. Football

5.1 Generalities

Venues

The venues for football will be two reduced synthetic fields at the FC95 Footballfield, rue du PARC

5.2 Competitions

Rules

The tournament will follow the FIFA rules, with following EPF2022 exceptions.

Participation

The number of players is not limited. 6 players and 1 Goalkeeper on the field (minimum 2 women).

Tournament

The tournament will be played in 3 groups on 2 reduced synthetic fields. Group A:4 teams; group B:4 teams; group C:3 teams

Each match will be played by seven players per team with a minimum of two female players.

The qualification matches will be play on 1 x 15 minutes

Quarterfinals, Semifinals and Final will be play on 2 x 15 minutes

Game won: 3 points, draw: 1 point, lost: 0 point

- Flying substitutions during the matches
- The offside rule will not be used
- The players sanctioned by a red card during a match, are excluded for that match only. The organizer reserves the right to exclude a player for behavior repeated anti-sportsman.

Qualification matches:

The qualification heats will take 1 x 15 minutes, no time stop and no side change.

In each group all the teams play one against the other (round Robin system).

The tree best teams of group A and B and the two best teams of group C are qualified for the quarterfinals.

To decide between teams with equality of points, will be considered : 1 $^{\circ}$ match between concerned teams, 2 $^{\circ}$ the goal differenceTo decide between teams with

equality of points, are considered : 1 ° match between concerned teams, 2° the goal difference.

Quarter-Finals:

The playtime is 2 x 15 minutes, no time stop, side change after 15 minutes.

The winner of each quarterfinal is qualified for the semi-finals.

In case of equality after 2 x 15 minutes, six players + one Goalkeeper on the ground at the end of playtime (30') take a penalty.

The teams not qualified for the semi-finals will be classified by goal difference. In case of equality the teams concerned are classified at the same place.

Semi-Finals:

The playtime is 2 x 15 minutes. The change of side will be done after 15 minutes.

In case of equality after 2 x 15 minutes, six + one Goalkeeper players on the ground at the end of playtime take a penalty.

The winner of each semi-final is qualified for the Final.

The teams not qualified for the semi-finals will be classified played the 3.Place

3.Place:

The playtime is 2 x 15 minutes. The change of side will be done after 15 minutes. In case of equality after regular playtime a prolongation of 5 minutes will be played. If after prolongation equality persists, six players + one Goalkeeper on the ground at the end of playtime take a penalty

Final:

The playtime is 2 x 15 minutes. The change of side will be done after 15 minutes. In case of equality after regular playtime a prolongation of 5 minutes will be played. If after prolongation equality persists, six players + one Goalkeeper on the ground at the end of playtime take a penalty

6.2 Competitions

Rules

The tournament will follow the rules of the Luxembourg Federation, FLBP, with following EPF2022 exceptions.

Participation

The number of players in the team is limited to five.

Tournament

- Each match is played by 3 competitors, 2 men and 1 woman, or 1 man and 2 women. During a match no substitution of players is allowed.

Qualification:

The qualification matches are played in two groups.

- The matches are played to 13 points but will be limited at 50 Minutes. If the score is tied at the end of the playing time, an additional end (mène) will be played to break the tie.
- The two winners and two second placed of each group are qualified for the Semi-Final.

Semi-finals and Final:

- The matches of Semi-finals and Final are played to 13 points.

7. Table Tennis

7.1 Generalities

Venue

The table tennis will be played on synthetic floor at the Hall Polyvalent, rue Denise Netgen

7.2 Competitions

Rules

The Table Tennis tournament will follow the rules of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF), with following EPF2022 exceptions.

Participation

The entering number of players is not limited.

Tournament

- The tournament is played in three singles' matches per team. The team consists of 2 men and 1 woman or by 1 man and 2 women.
- Each one of the three matches will be played on two winning sets. Each set is played to 11 points.
- Shoes with black soles are not allowed indoors.

Players are required to bring their paddles. Paddles can be provided to players who don't bring their own by the organizer at registration time.

Qualifications:

The qualification matches are played in 4 groups. In each group all the teams will play one against the other (Round Robin System)

The two best teams of each group will be qualified for the quarterfinals. To decide between the teams with equality of points, will be taken into account the total of the points played in the matches. The teams not qualified for the quarterfinals, will be classified according to the result of the played matches. In case of equality the teams concerned are classified in the same place.

Ouarter-Finals:

The winner of each quarterfinal is qualified for the semi-finals.

The teams not qualified for the semi-finals will be classified according to the results in the qualifications. In case of equality the teams concerned are classified in the same place.

Semi-Finals:

The winner of each semi-final is qualified for the Final.

The teams not qualified for the semi-finals will be classified by the results in the qualifications. In case of equality the teams concerned are classified in the same place.

8. Indiaca

8.1 Generalities

Venues

The Indiaca competitions are held in the main sports halls with synthetic floors on regular fields

8.2 Competitions

Rules

The tournament will follow the Indiaca rules, with following EPF2022 exceptions.

- A team scores a point:
 - Ø by successfully grounding the ball on the opponent's court.
 - Ø when the opponent team commits a fault.
- If the serving team wins a rally, it scores a point and continues to serve.
- If the receiving team wins the rally, it scores a point and it must serve next, after having rotated.
- The three players along the net are front-row, the two others are back-row players.
- The team is entitled to a maximum of three hits (in addition to blocking), for returning the ball.
- A player may not hit the ball two times consecutively, except for blocking.
- The ball may not touch any part of the body, except from the hands and the arms up to the elbows.
- During the game the ball may touch the net while crossing it, except for the service.
- A player is not permitted to pass his/her hands beyond the net.
- A player commits a fault, when:
 - Ø he/she intrudes upon the opponent's space in the air, over or under the net
 - Ø he/she intrudes into the opponent's playing court
 - Ø he/she touches the net, antennae, ropes or posts
- A back row player may also complete an attack hit from within the front zone, if at the moment of the contact, the ball is below the top of the net.
- No player is permitted to complete an attack hit directly on the opponent's service, when the ball is in the front zone and above the top of the net.
- Blocking an opponent's service is forbidden.

Participating

The number of players is not limited.

Tournament

The tournament will be played on 3 groups on 3 playgrounds. Group A:3 teams ; group B:4 teams ; group C:4 teams

The playground is a rectangle of 16 x 6.10 m.

A net is stretched over the center line. The net height is 225 cm for mixed.

Each match will be played by five players with a minimum of two female players.

- The qualification heats will take 1 x 20 minutes

Game won: 3 points, draw: 1 point, lost: 0 point

- Flying substitutions during the matches
- Shoes with black soles are not allowed indoor.

In each group all the teams play one against the other (round Robin system).

The tree best teams of group B and C and the two best teams of group A are qualified for the quarterfinals.

Ouarter-Finals:

The playing time is 1x20 minutes, no time stop, no time-out.

The winner of each quarterfinal is qualified for the semi-finals.

The teams not qualified for the semi-finals will be classified by points difference. In case of equality the teams concerned are classified at the same place.

Semi-Finals:

The playtime is 1 x 20 minutes.

The winner of each semi-final is qualified for the Final.

The teams not qualified for the semi-finals will be classified played the 3. Place

Final:

The playtime is 2 x 21 points. The change of sides will be done after 21 points. To win a set, a team must score 21 points, with a minimum of two points difference. In case of equality-of sets, a third set of 15 points must be played.
