

# Information meeting

## Correctly separate your organic waste

The municipality of Schiffflange has observed that the organic waste from its residents contains foreign objects. To raise awareness of this issue, an information meeting will be organised:

**February 12, 2025, at 7:00 PM in the Hall Polyvalent**  
(1a, Chemin de Bergem, L-3817 Schiffflange)

To address this problem, the organic waste bins will be inspected before collection in the coming months, and a card system will be implemented: **green**, **yellow** and **red** card.

## Card system

- A **GREEN** card for correctly separated waste
- A **YELLOW** card for organic waste with few foreign objects
- A **RED** card for organic waste with many foreign objects

**Examples of foreign objects:** plastic bags, Tetra Pak packaging, metals, glass, coffee capsules, diapers and sanitary pads, stones, soil, debris, ashes, cigarette butts, domestic animal waste, vacuum bags, textiles, footwear...

The organic waste bins that received a **RED** card **will NOT** be emptied.

The affected households **must remove the non-compostable materials** and present their organic bin during the next collection.
